

Thornhill Community Trust (TCT) Charitable aims

- 1. Improve quality of life by providing a framework for community development in Thornhill and its environs
- 2. to preserve, restore and improve the environment through the provision, maintenance and/or improvement of public open space and other public amenities and other environmental and townscape regeneration projects
- 3. to provide within the Operating Area facilities for recreation and other leisure time occupation available to the public at large with a view to improving their conditions of life
- 4. to promote, establish and operate other schemes of a charitable nature for the benefit of the community

TCT Trustees

Trustees are members who take a lead in TCT by:

- maintaining an overview of the TCT's activities to ensure the aims of the trust are fulfilled
- managing the trust's finances and responsibilities as a charity
- reporting to the trustees meetings about the groups they are involved in
- supporting TCT events and activities
- creating links with other communities
- ensuring volunteers and those attending events are safe and well-treated

Trustees have equal, collective responsibility for these duties. Trustee meetings are held every 6 - 8 weeks.

TCT Members

Members can get involved to whatever level suits them, which can include:

- getting involved with active project groups (e.g. paths, biodiversity, Thornhill Views, village tubs)
- attending TCT events and activities
- volunteering at the activities arranged by the TCT groups
- generating new ideas and getting involved with setting up new projects in the village which are supported by TCT e.g. Thornhill Futures, Light Up Thornhill
- attending and voting at members meetings and the AGM
