WHEREAS Stirling Council incorporated under the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1997 propose to convey to us The Trustees the land known as Thornhill North Common in the County of Perth as shown on the plan annexed and signed as relative hereto ("The Common")

And WHEREAS The Trustees are to hold The Common in Trust for the residents of the village of Thornhill and its environs being the area defined by The Register of Electors for Thornhill (such residents being hereinafter called "The Inhabitants")

NOW THEREFORE we The Trustees hereby irrevocably DECLARE AS FOLLOWS NAMELY:-

(FIRST) There shall never be less than eight Trustees who shall comprise the four office bearers of Thornhill and Blairdrummond Community Council (ex officio) and four of The Inhabitants elected in terms of the rules set out below.

(SECOND) The Common shall be held by us as Trustees aforesaid and our successors in all time coming for the common good of The Inhabitants with due regard to their traditional rights without distinction of political religious or other persuasions with the object of enabling them to continue the rights of commonty and access which have been exercised and asserted since time immemorial; and for improving the conditions of life for them with due regard to the natural assets of The Common. It shall not be lawful for The Trustees to sell the Common or any part thereof nor to effect any material change of its use or tenure unless authorised by a 75% majority of The inhabitants at a Public Meeting convened for the purpose after wide and proper publicity.

(THIRD) The Trustees shall be bound and obliged to comply with the following administrative rules namely:-


- (1) Any changes to the membership of the Trust shall be taken only by a majority of The Inhabitants present at a Public Meeting to be held in Thornhill after wide and proper publication.
- (2) There shall be at least two meetings of The Trustees annually open to all The Inhabitants and held only after due publication throughout Thornhill and its environs.
- (3) The Trustees shall elect annually Their Chairman Secretary Vice Chairman and Treasurer.
- (4) The Annual General Meeting shall be held each November.
- (5) All Trustees who are not appointed ex officio shall retire each year but shall be eligible for re-election.
- (6) The Treasurer shall keep proper accounts and present them to The Trustees at the Annual General Meeting. Approval shall be signified by subscription by the Chairman and the Treasurer.
- (7) A majority of The Trustees Present in The United Kingdom shall constitute a quorum.
- (8) A Trustee will require to be at least eighteen years of age.
 - (9) A Trustee shall be deemed to have resigned forthwith:-

- (a) on becoming apparently insolvent
- (b) on conviction of a crime of dishonesty
- c) on ceasing to qualify ex officio
- d) On ceasing to be resident in Thornhill
- e) on a vote to that effect by a 75% majority of the Trustees except that item (d) shall not apply to a Trustee who qualifies ex officio and whose qualification does not, therefore, derive from their residence in Thornhill.
- (10) Decisions on all other matters shall be by a simple majority and quorum of The Trustees with the Chairman having a casting vote.
- (11) In the event of the resignation or deemed resignation of a Trustee who is not ex officion the vacancy will be filled at a Public Meeting of The Inhabitants convened after wide and proper publication within six months of the resignation.
- (12) Any changes in the qualifications of The Trustees required in consequence of unforseen circumstances shall be agreed only at a Public Meeting of The Inhabitants convened after wide and proper publicity.
