

RULES

- 1 Show open to competitors within a 10 mile radius of the village
- 2 Entries must be made on the form provided by giving numbers of classes in Schedule.
- 3 Each exhibit must have an official label securely attached. These can be obtained from the Secretary when exhibits are being staged. All wines and preserves should be clearly marked.
- 4 Exhibits in Pot Plant, Flower, Vegetable & Miscellaneous Sections must be property of exhibitor for at least two months prior to show.
- 5 No competitor will be allowed more than one entry in each class.
- 6 **Garden competition suspended**
- 7 Articles for competition will be received in the hall on **Friday evening between 7.30pm and 9.00pm**, and on the morning of the Show from 7.30am until 9.00am, at which time the judging will commence.
- 8 THE JUDGES' DECISIONS WILL BE FINAL.
- 9 All due care will be given to the exhibits but the Society will not be responsible for loss or damage. No items will be removed from the hall until close of the Show at 4pm.
- 10 All exhibits must be uplifted after 4pm and before 4.30pm otherwise they will be binned.
- 11 In the event of a tie for any of the Awards based on points, the person with most First placings will be declared the winner. If there is still a tie, the number of Second Placings will be taken into account.
- 12 Society vases are available at the Hall Society vases, appropriate to the exhibit, must be used, unless stated in entry Oasis is also available, however entrants are encouraged to use sustainable products.
